Maulaffenbäck	<u>Hotel Zum Winzernaennle</u> A charming, family owned and operated city hotel with tradition right in the heart of Würzburg. The location is superb. No other hotel is better situated to make our stay enjoyable; located in the charming pedestrian zone; just steps away from all major attractions and, of course, we know the family well! <u>STRAMU</u> With up to 100.000 visitors, the STRAMU festival (7-9 September) is one of the biggest festival for street music and street art in Europe. As the STRAMU festival takes no entrance fee, they ask you to reward all artists kindly! <u>Facebook STRAMU</u> In the Distelhäuser Biergarten at Unteren Markt, you can bring your own food! <u>Maulaffenbäck</u> The Weinstube has been here since 1907 and they retain the tradition formerly common in many wine bars, that you can bring your own Brotzeit (what we Scots would call our 'pieces' - between 10am and 12pm. Don't worry, you can of course just order a meal if you don't want to DIY it!

Included in the price is a cup of coffee at Café Schönborn on Market Square opposite the Falkenhaus.</p>

Reserved.</p>	<p><u>Marienburg</u> The most dominating feature of the city; it towers above it all. Take a tour and learn about its history. Tuesday – Sunday 10 am - 5 pm €4 Free entrance with Welcome card. Takes about 20 minutes to walk a steep path but you can get there by #9 bus.</p> <p><u>Käppele</u> Enjoy splendid architecture and a glamorous interior decoration at the Baroque pilgrimage church. Downhill is worth the hike via the Stations of the Cross with life-size sculptures; you finish near a tram stop next to the river.</p> <p><u>Alte Mainbrücke</u> From the old bridge, enjoy fantastic views of the Marienberg; Käppele; the Main river and the famous Vineyards.</p> <p><u>Dom St. Kilian</u> The Cathedral is the fourth largest Romanesque cathedral in Germany and is home to exquisite artifacts from many centuries. Turn right as you come out of the hotel it is a mere 30 metre stroll.</p> <p><u>Marktplatz</u> Regular markets and festivals/events. It is divided into the Upper Market (east, at the Falkenhaus) and the Lower Market (southwest, with Obeliskbrunnen). North of the Marienkapelle, only separated by a narrow passage, is the Marienplatz.</p> <p><u>Backöfele</u> A cozy gem full of lust for tradition and down-to-earthness, where you will enjoy a stylish evening as well as your hearty celebration. Eat in the counter room is the famous old oven, which owes its name to the Backöfele. In this probably most original of all Frankish Stammtisch rounds new arrivals are of course always welcome with a good glass of wine and some delicious delicacies.</p>

It extends over several parts of the building to the cathedral street. Oldest area is the Grafeneckart. In the town hall is among other things the office of the Oberbürgermeister and the city administration. The Council Chamber for the City Council meetings and the historic Wenceslas Hall. In the entrance area on the side of the fountain is the memorial room to the victims of the bombing raid on Würzburg on 16 March 1945 and a tactile model of the entire building. Tram Trips: They are free with your Welcome Card. Just remember to get off! See detailed info on the various tram and bus trip suggestions. <u>Dallenbergbad</u> Outdoor swimming pool in a huge park. <u>Dehner Garten Centre</u> <u>Neubert</u> and <u>Restaurant</u> <u>Wirtshaus Lämmle</u> One of our favourites. The Lämmle - a Franconian, rustic inn is located directly in the city centre, in Marienplatz right at the lower market behind the Marienkapelle.
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Tues 11.09	<p>Bus Tour: Rhön: Kreuzberg</p> <p>am: 8:30am Bus pick up at Hotel Winzermännle</p> <p>Stop off at brewery; arrive at monastery.</p> <p>pm: Walk up hill; see cross; Coffee & Kuchen at Border Post</p> <p>Return to Würzburg approx. 7pm</p>	Monastery	20:00 Ratskeller	<p><u>Kreuzberg</u> Kreuzberg Monastery (<i>Kloster Kreuzberg</i>), which is situated just below the summit of the mountain, is one of the main attractions as well. There are frequent pilgrimages to the monastery church. The monastery is also famous for its beer, which was brewed on site by the monks until about 1992. Today the beer is brewed by laypersons under the supervision of the monks. Three different beers (Dunkel, Pilsner and Hefe-Weizen) are produced year-round and a fourth (Weihnachts-Bock) is available during the Christmas season. Approximately 8,500 hectoliters of beer are brewed each year at the monastery. The current Braumeister ("brew master") is Ulrich Klebl.</p> <p><u>Schwarzer Moor Nature Trail</u> The Black Moor is part of the Europe-wide network of protected areas NATURA 2000. As part of the core zones in the UNESCO biosphere reserve it is the showcase of nature and deserve special protection. The moor is home to a variety of rare animal - and plant species. Visitors walk along a specially constructed boardwalk which protects the moor from harm.</p> <p><u>Former East German border</u> A short walk from the car park takes one to the former border to East Germany. Here you will find one of the few remaining towers and parts of the fencing that separated friends and family on either side of the border.</p> <p><u>Cafe at the Schwarzen Moor</u> with Bratwurst and even veggie bratwurst, and the best Käsekuchen (cheesecake) in the world</p> <p><u>Ratskeller</u> In the heart of the city of Würzburg, located between the Cathedral and the old Main Bridge; just 50 metres from our hotel (left). Excellent Franconian food and wine in a great location! This is simply the most fantastic restaurant set in a beautiful square with the quality of food and wine to match the view. The dishes are not only tasty but are beautifully presented. Enjoy with a beer or the local dry white wine (available by the glass); to finish, share an apple strudel!</p>

With Dr Bauer & Sabine.</p>	<p><u>Landesgartenschau</u> <u>The State Horticultural Show</u> Just two kilometres away from Würzburg's City Centre, at eye-level with the historic Fortress Marienberg, interested visitors can not only experience rare plants and blossoming landscapes, but also get to know a location for new ideas - 95 hectares of opportunities and potential. In a high-lying area with a varied history, the new district of Hubland - featuring a large park, diverse types of housing, central facilities and a social infrastructure - is being constructed. This is a district that will strengthen the city of Würzburg as a centre of knowledge and work will make it an even more attractive place to live.</p> <p>In addition to numerous themed gardens, trends around nature and the art of gardening, urban gardening and mobility, as well as attractive play and adventure areas, visitors to the Horticultural Show can also embark on a journey through time. The exhibition will lead through the multifaceted history of this area, which was once a potato field and the Galgenberg, the starting point of flight pioneers and finally a US forces base.</p> <p>English guide will meet us at 2pm.</p> <p>Bus Nr. 14 or 29 from Bus station / Main station to Landesgartenschau, Bus Stop Landesgartenschau Süd (South) or Ost (East)</p> <p>Wheelchairs and electric scooters are available from 9am to 6pm. Deposit of €30 for wheelchair and €50 for scooter required.</p> <p><u>Bürgerspital</u> Traditional restaurant belonging to one of the oldest wineries in the area. We will be joined by Dr Bauer, one of the three Bürgermeister (Lord Mayors) of Würzburg and Sabine Hermann, of the city's twinning office. Also attending will be our old friends Karl and Erna Schmidt from Union Bayern Bretagne.</p> <p>A romantic sheltered courtyard in the heart of Würzburg where you can enjoy cool drinks and Franconian specialties in the shady courtyard of the Bürgerspital Weinstuben.
